


#### Which of the following applies to you? Check all that apply.






#### Which city or township do you reside in?


#### Within the City of Boulder, which sub-community do you reside?



















How many of those times have your waste bins been broken by a black bear specifically?










How many times have you received a trash violation for not properly securing your trash or compost within the past 4 years while living in the Bear Protection Ordinance zone?






### Have you ever had an interaction with a black bear in Boulder that you consider to be negative?










#### Which actions do you take to reduce conflict with bears?












### If you saw a black bear in an urban area of Boulder, how likely would you be to call these groups?






### In terms of wildlife management, how much do you support the work of these groups?

















#### Category breakdown of wildlife-related groups
